To: All Residents Returning to Norfolk County and Haldimand County Who Have Returned After Traveling Outside of Canada

RE: SECTION 22 ORDER – EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

A Section 22 Order, under the *Health Protection and Promotion Act (HPPA)*, R.S.O. 1990, c.H.7 has been issued by Dr. Shanker Nesathurai, Medical Officer of Health of the Haldimand Norfolk Health Unit to all residents returning to Norfolk County and Haldimand County who have travelled outside of Canada and are returning as of March 22, 2020.

You are hereby ordered to take the following actions:

1. Self-Isolate yourself at your residence immediately for a period of 14 days upon your return until this order is rescinded by the Medical Officer of Health or designate.
2. This order prohibits you from traveling outside of your home while this order is in effect, with the only exception being to seek medical assessment and/or treatment.

THE REASON(S) for this ORDER is that:

1. There is the potential for transmission of the COVID-19 virus among residents who have travelled outside of Canada and returning to Norfolk County and Haldimand County.

Therefore, based on the reason(s) noted above, I am of the opinion, on reasonable and probable grounds that:

1. a communicable disease exists or may exist or there is an immediate risk of an outbreak of a communicable disease in the health unit served by me;
2. the communicable disease presents a risk to the health of persons in the health unit served by me; and
3. the requirements specified in this order are necessary in order to decrease or eliminate the risk to health presented by the communicable disease.

NOTICE

TAKE NOTICE THAT you have the right to a hearing before the Health Services Appeal and Review Board in accordance with Section 44 of the Health Protection and Promotion Act. You must mail or deliver a notice in writing requesting a hearing to the undersigned and to the Health Services Appeal and Review Board, 151 Bloor St. W., Toronto, Ontario M5S 2T5, within 15 days after this Order is served on you.

AND TAKE FURTHER NOTICE THAT although a hearing may be requested, this Order takes effect when it is served upon you.

FAILURE to comply with this Order is an offence for which you may be liable, on conviction, to a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for every day or part of each day on which the offence occurs or continues.
