Re: COVID-19 case, contact and outbreak management: Omicron surge

Dear Long-Term Care Home and Retirement Home Colleagues:

Please be advised that the Ministry of Health has released updated guidance for COVID-19 case, contact and outbreak management. Key points in the guidance that Haldimand-Norfolk Health Unit (HNHU) would like you to be aware of include:

- All high-risk contacts associated with a high-risk setting (e.g., hospitals, health care settings, LTCH and RH) of the case must self-isolate for 10 days (regardless of vaccination status or previously positive status).
- All high-risk contacts associated with a high-risk setting must be tested in accordance with <u>COVID-19 Provincial Testing and Clearance Guidance</u>
  - Recommend testing immediately
  - o If the initial test was negative, repeat testing on or after day 7
  - o If the initial test was done on or after day 7 of isolation, repeat testing is not necessary
- If the high-risk contact is a staff member in a health care or congregate living setting, and they are asymptomatic and fully vaccinated, they may work under work-self isolation if clinical care would be severely compromised without additional staffing.
