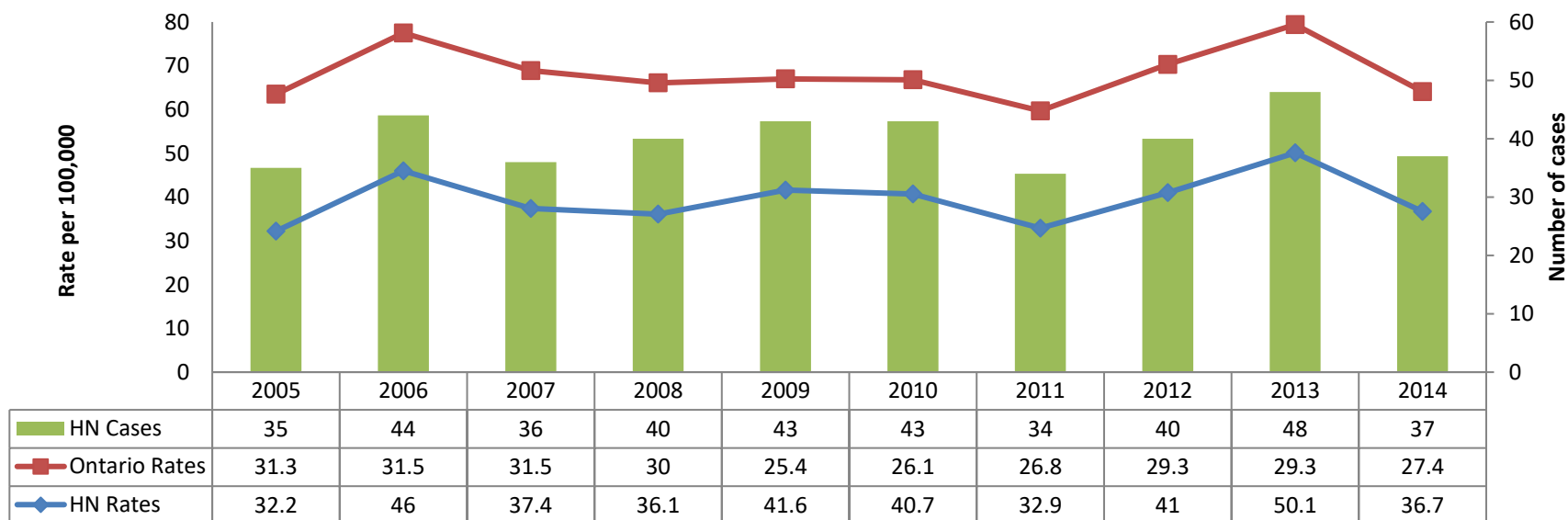


Incidence of Infectious Diseases – Statistics in Haldimand and Norfolk

- ❖ Between 2005 and 2014, the average number of Campylobacter Enteritis cases per year was 40, in Haldimand and Norfolk.

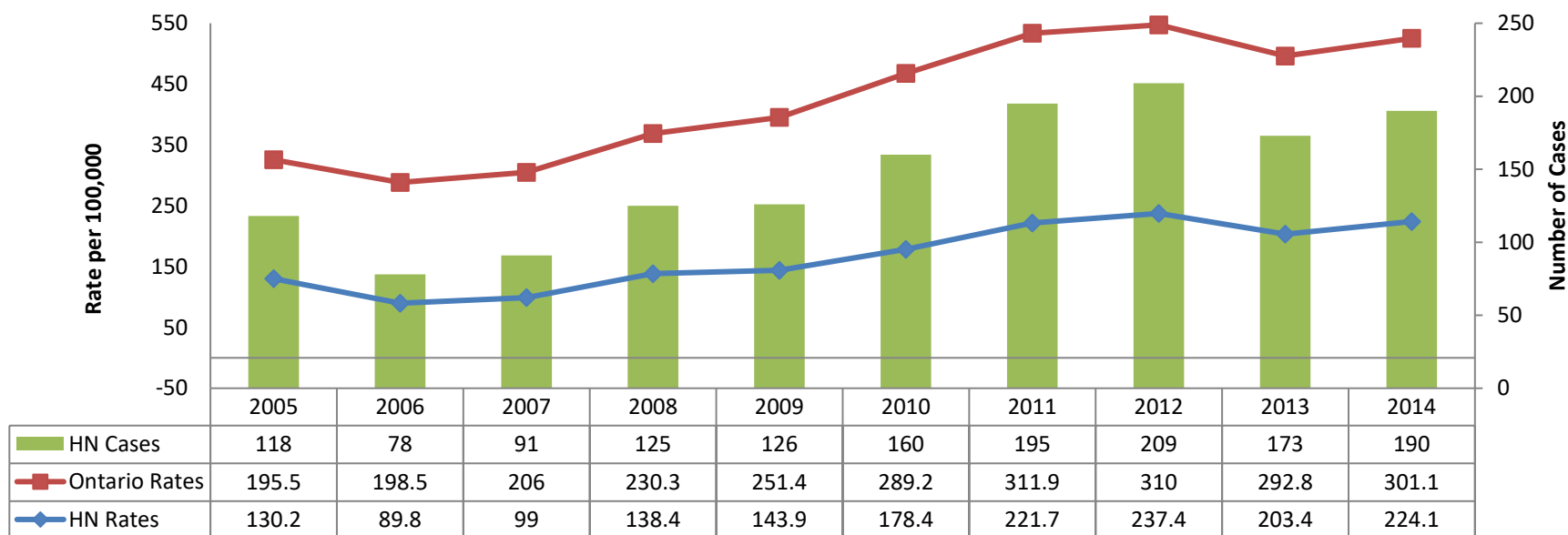
Incidence of Campylobacter Enteritis, Age Standardized Rate, Haldimand and Norfolk, 2005-2014

- ❖ Between 2005 and 2014, the average number of Chlamydia cases per year was 147, in Haldimand and Norfolk.
- ❖ In 2014, the rate of Chlamydia was significantly lower in Haldimand and Norfolk compared to Ontario.

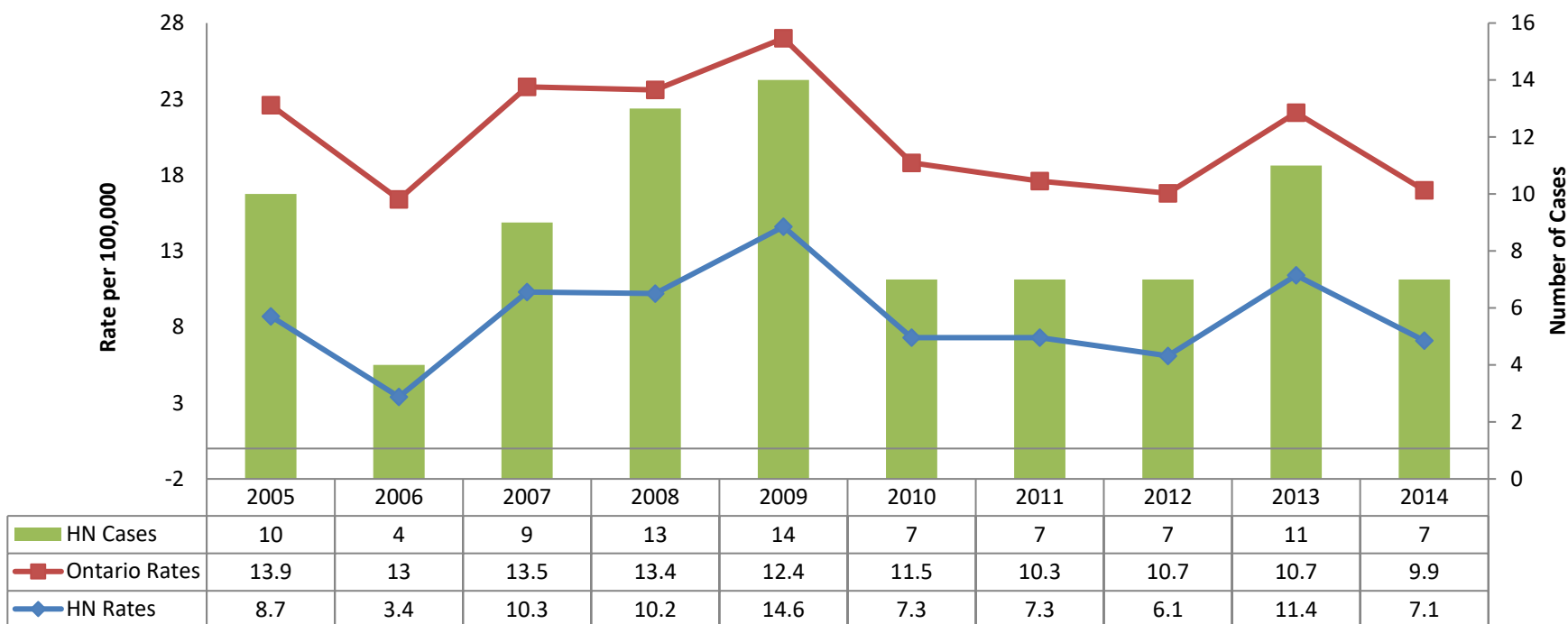
Incidence of Chlamydia, Age Standardized Rate, Haldimand and Norfolk, 2005-2014

❖ Between 2005 and 2014, the average number of cases of Giardiasis per year was 9, in Haldimand and Norfolk.

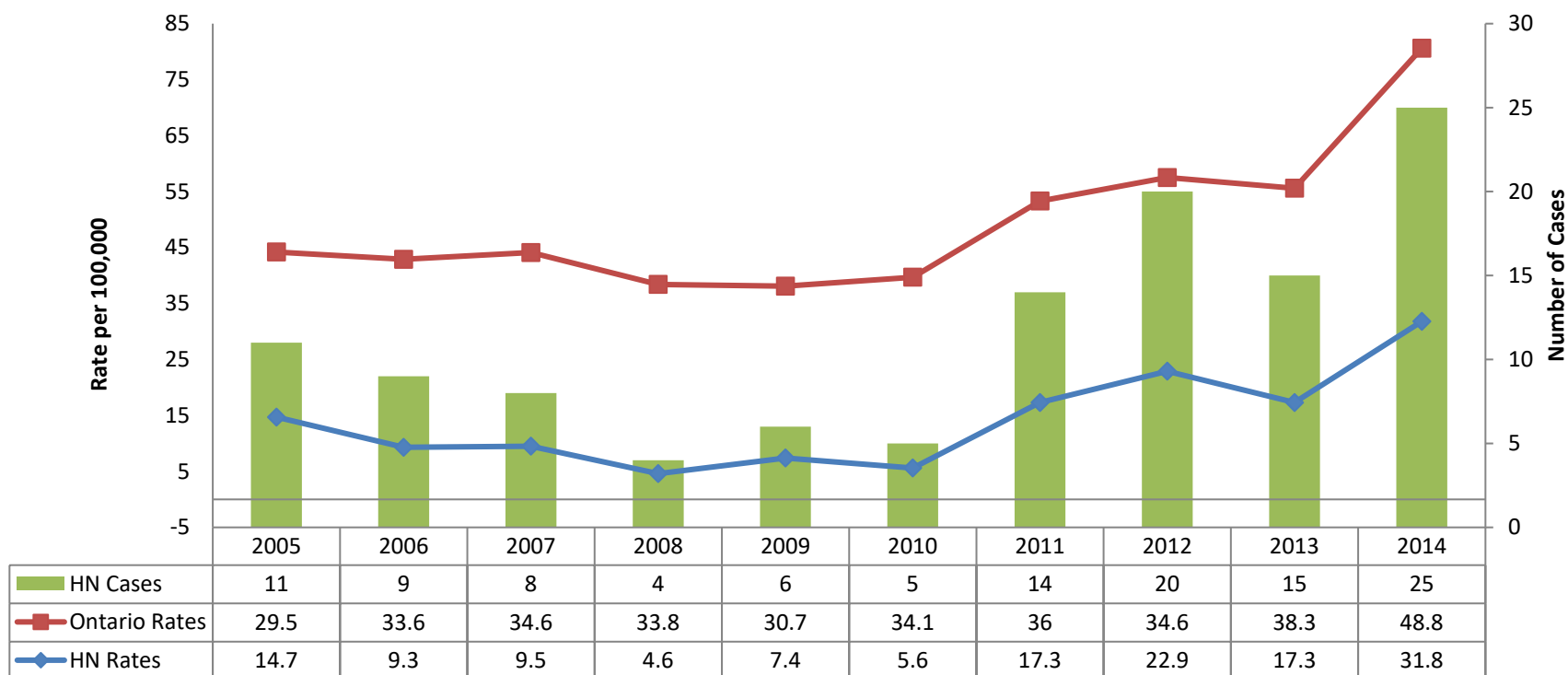
Incidence of Giardiasis, Age Standardized Rate, Haldimand and Norfolk, 2005-2014

- ❖ Between 2005 and 2014, the average number of cases of Gonorrhoea per year was 12, in Haldimand and Norfolk.
- ❖ In 2014, the rate of Gonorrhoea in Haldimand and Norfolk was significantly lower than Ontario.

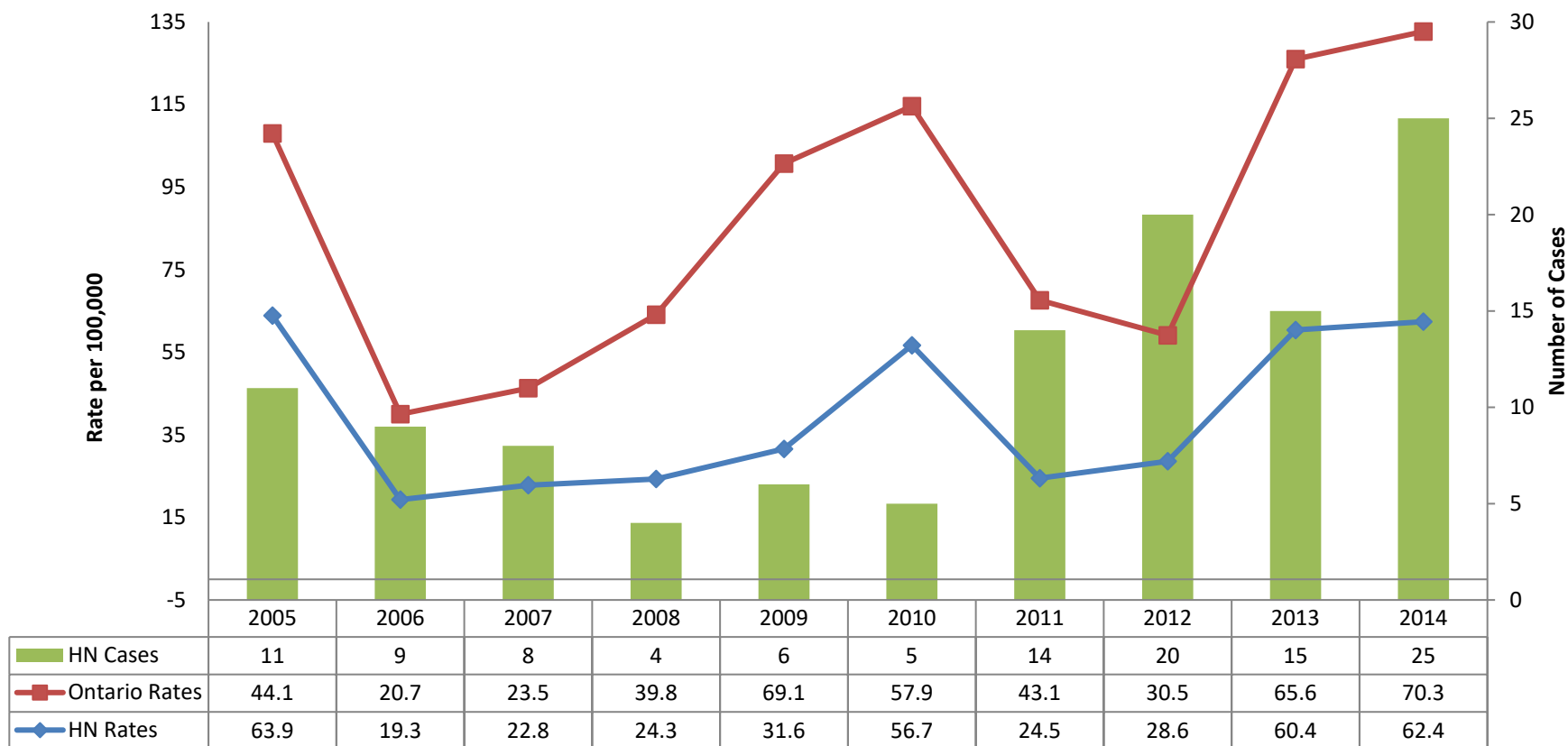
Number of Cases, Incidence of Gonorrhoea, Age Standardized Rate, Haldimand and Norfolk, 2005-2014

❖ Between 2005 and 2014, the average number of cases of Influenza per year was 12, in Haldimand and Norfolk.

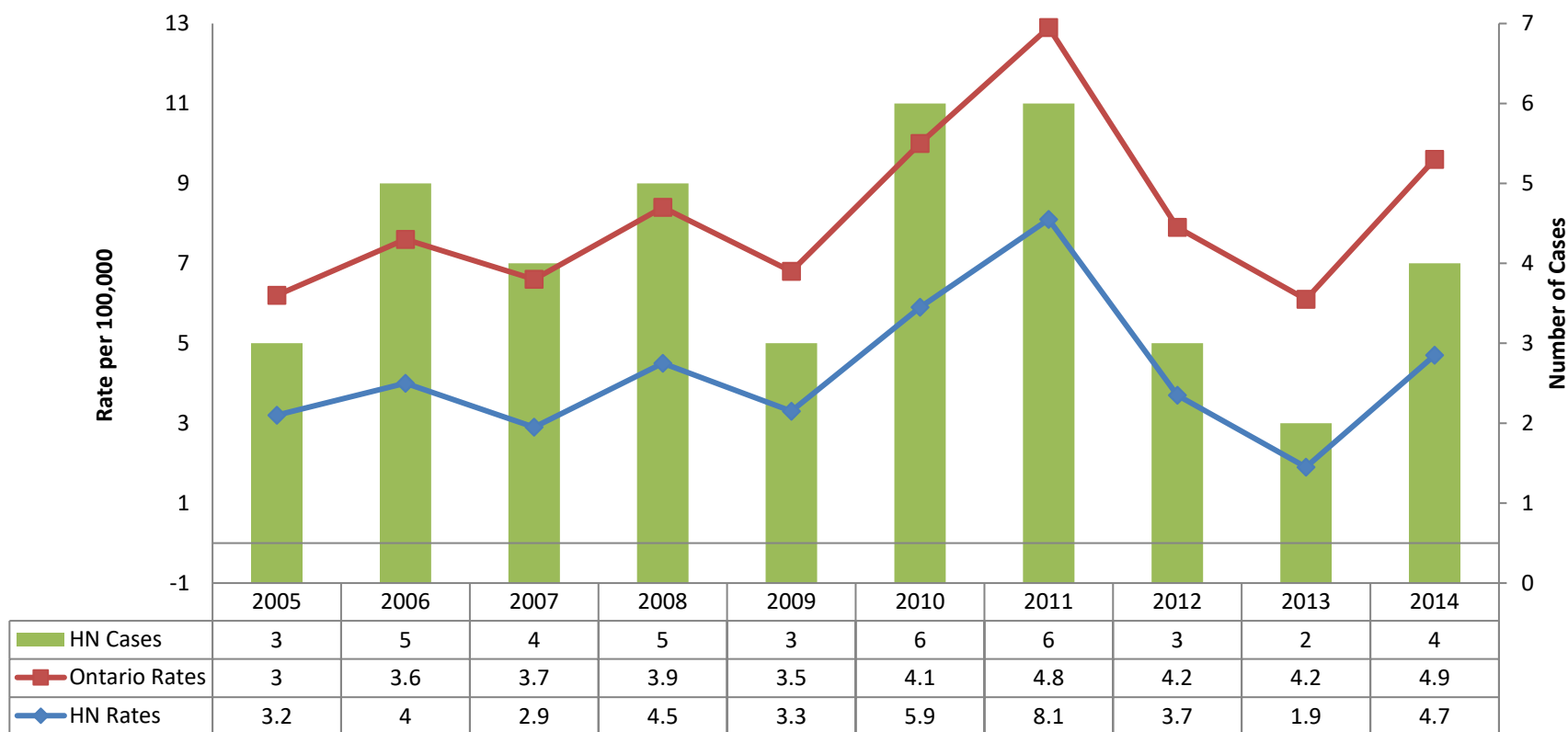
Incidence of Influenza, Age Standardized Rate, Haldimand and Norfolk, 2005-2014

- ❖ Between 2005 and 2014, the average number of cases of Invasive Group A Streptococcal Disease per year was 4, in Haldimand and Norfolk.

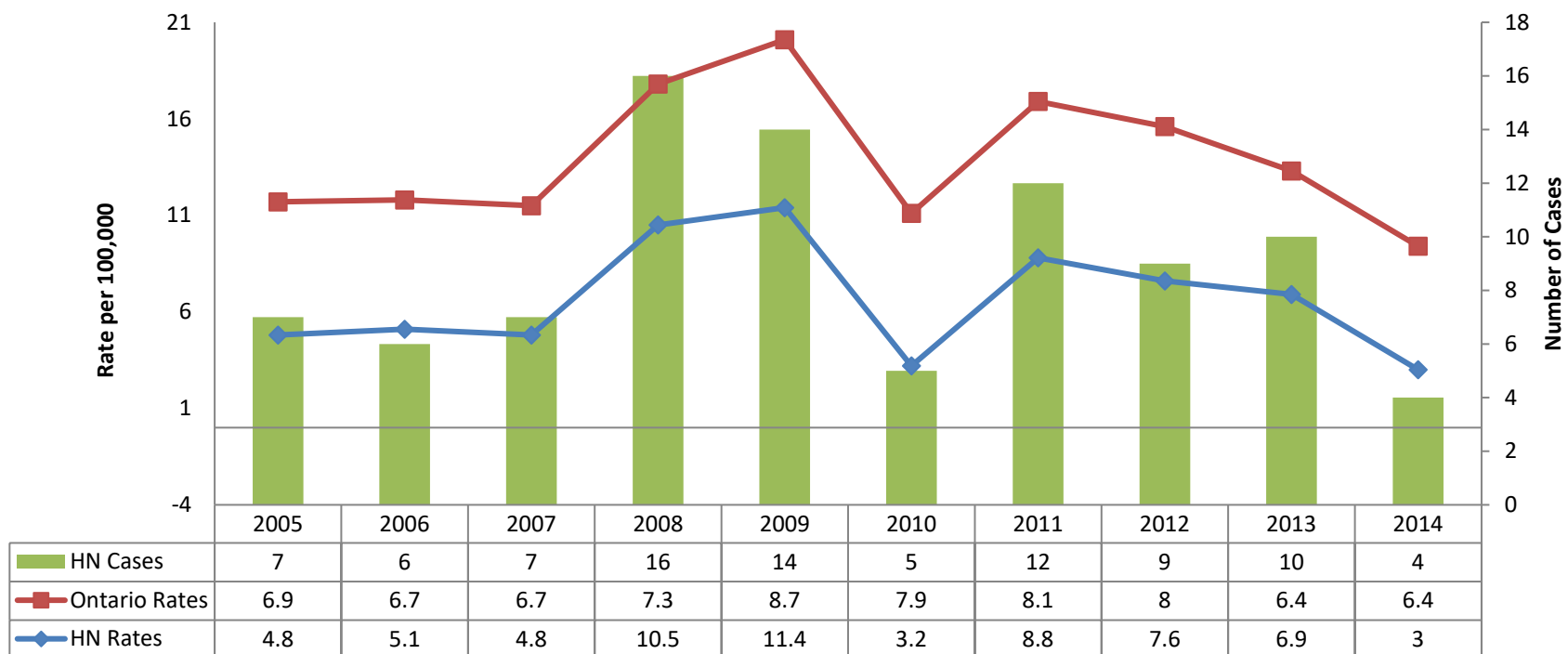
Incidence of Invasive Group A Streptococcal Disease, Age Standardized Rate, Haldimand and Norfolk, 2005-2014

- ❖ Between 2005 and 2014, the average number of cases of Invasive Pneumococcal Disease per year was 9, in Haldimand and Norfolk.

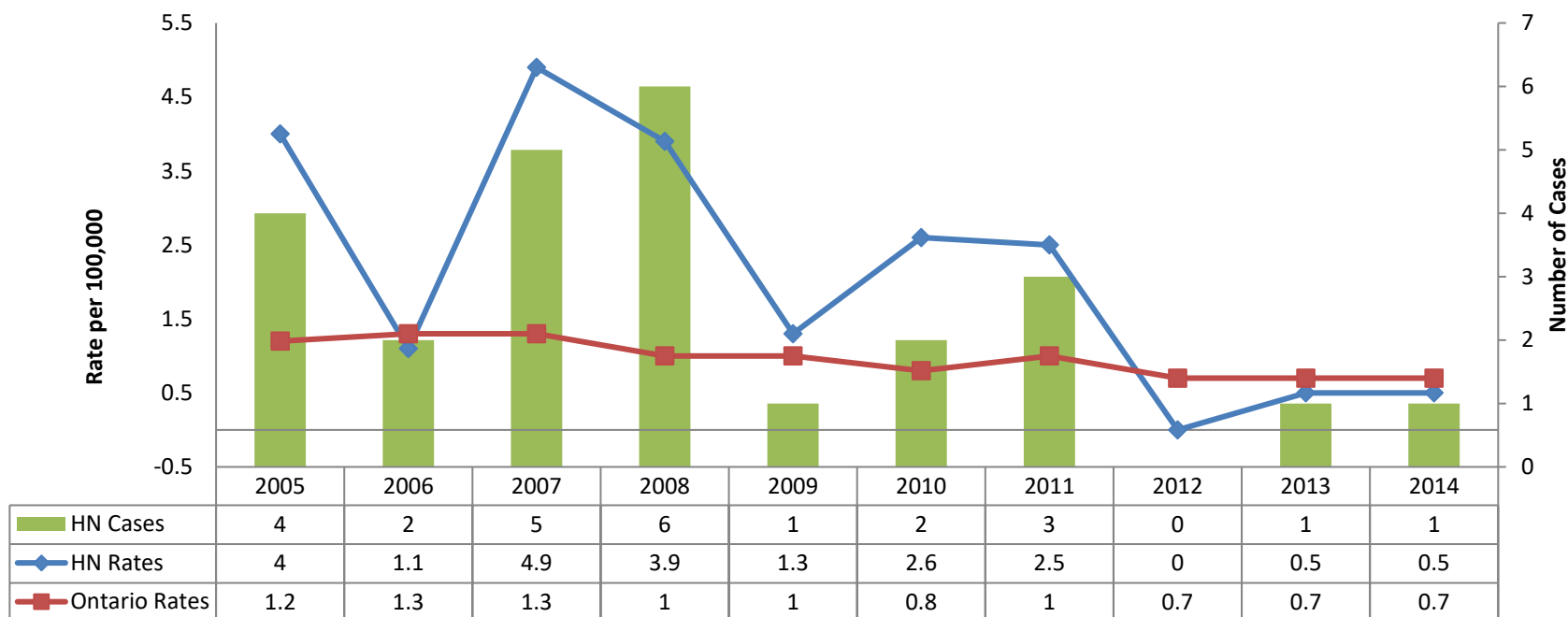
Incidence of Invasive Pneumococcal Disease, Age Standardized Rate, Haldimand and Norfolk, 2005-2014

❖ Between 2005 and 2014, the average number of cases of Hepatitis B (Acute) per year was 3, in Haldimand and Norfolk.

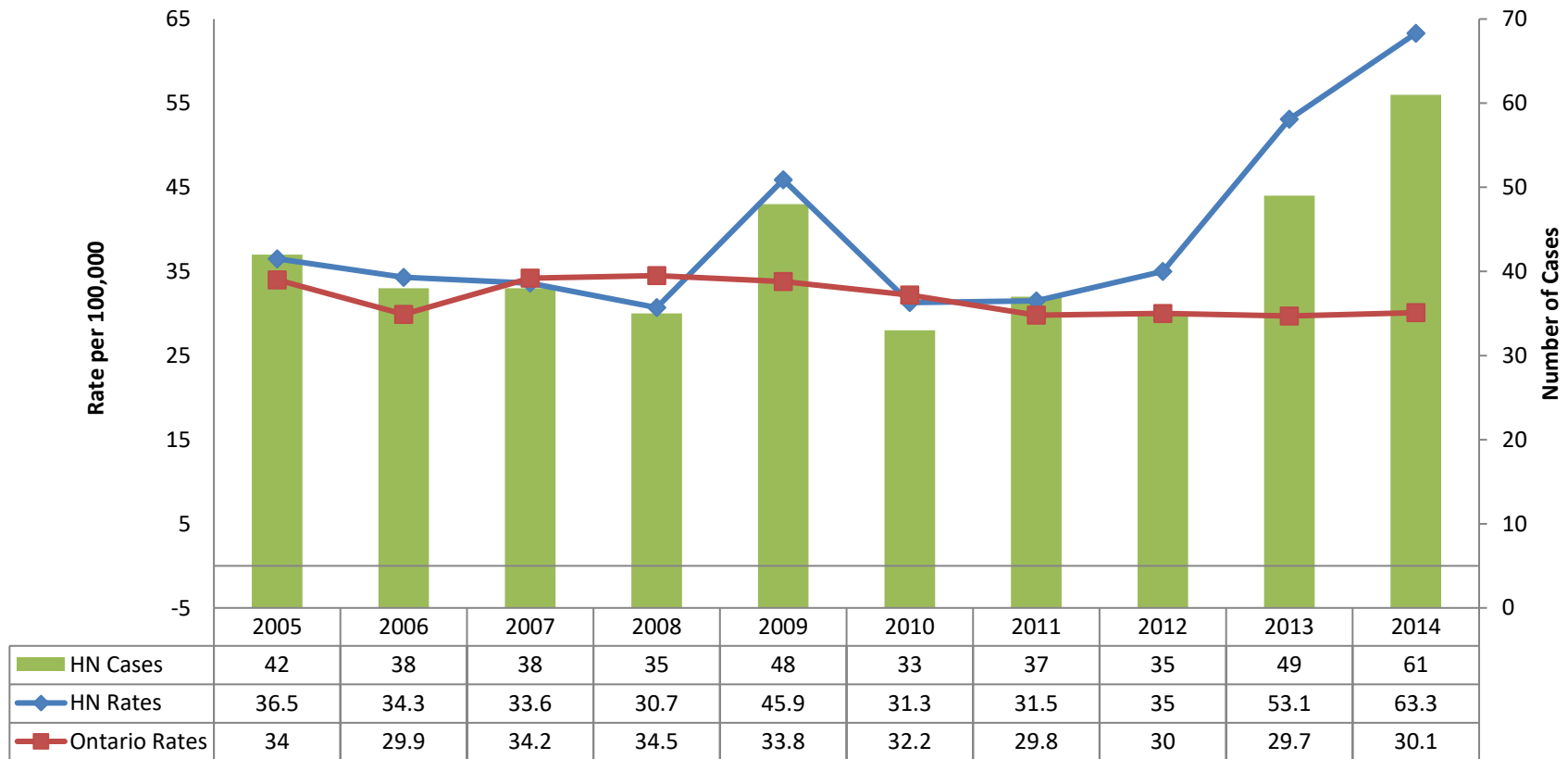
Incidence of Hepatitis B (Acute), Age Standardized Rate, Haldimand and Norfolk, 2005-2014

- ❖ In 2014, the rate of Hepatitis C was significantly higher in Haldimand and Norfolk compared to Ontario.

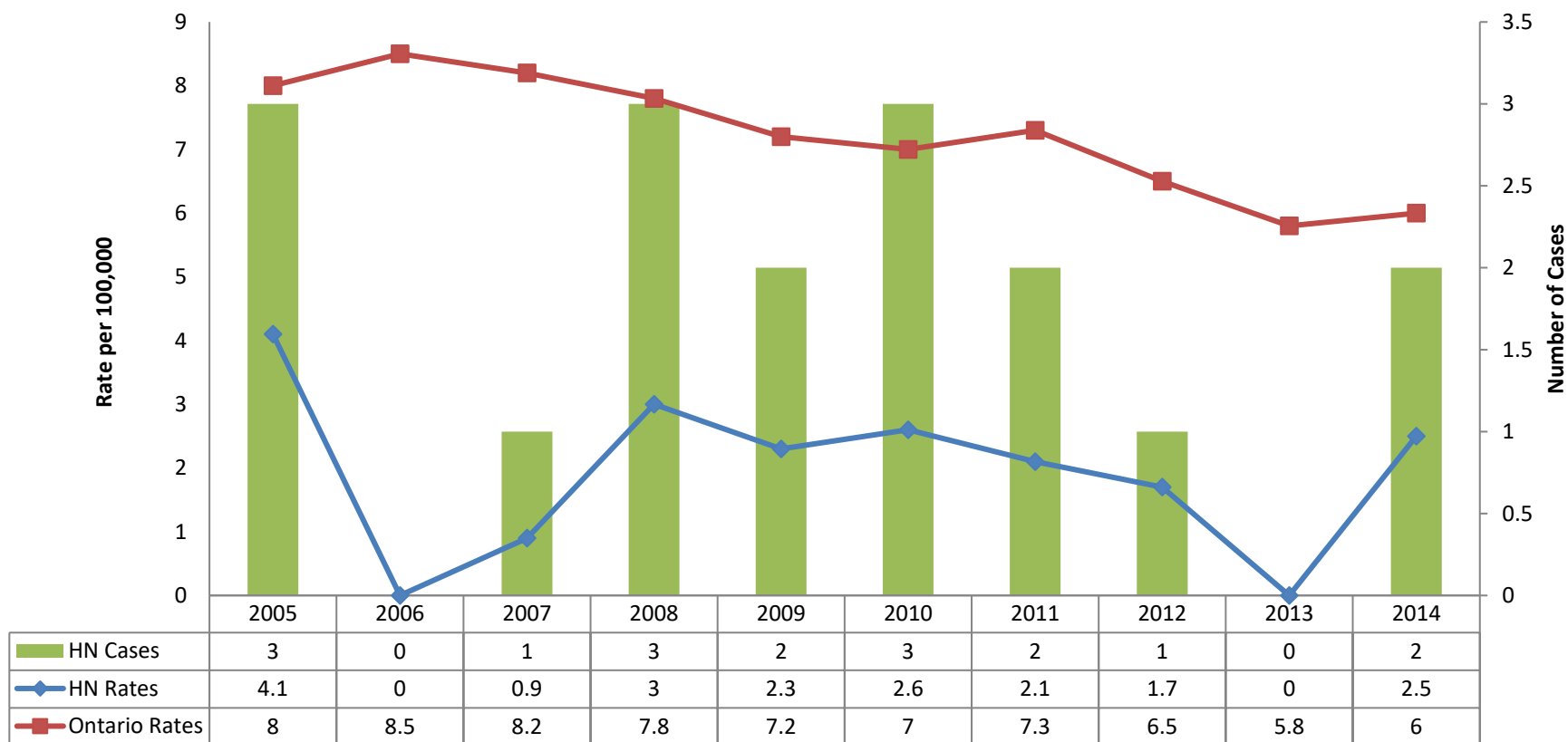
Incidence of Hepatitis C, Age Standardized Rate, Haldimand and Norfolk, 2005-2014

❖ Between 2005 and 2014, the average number of cases of HIV per year was 2, was Haldimand and Norfolk.

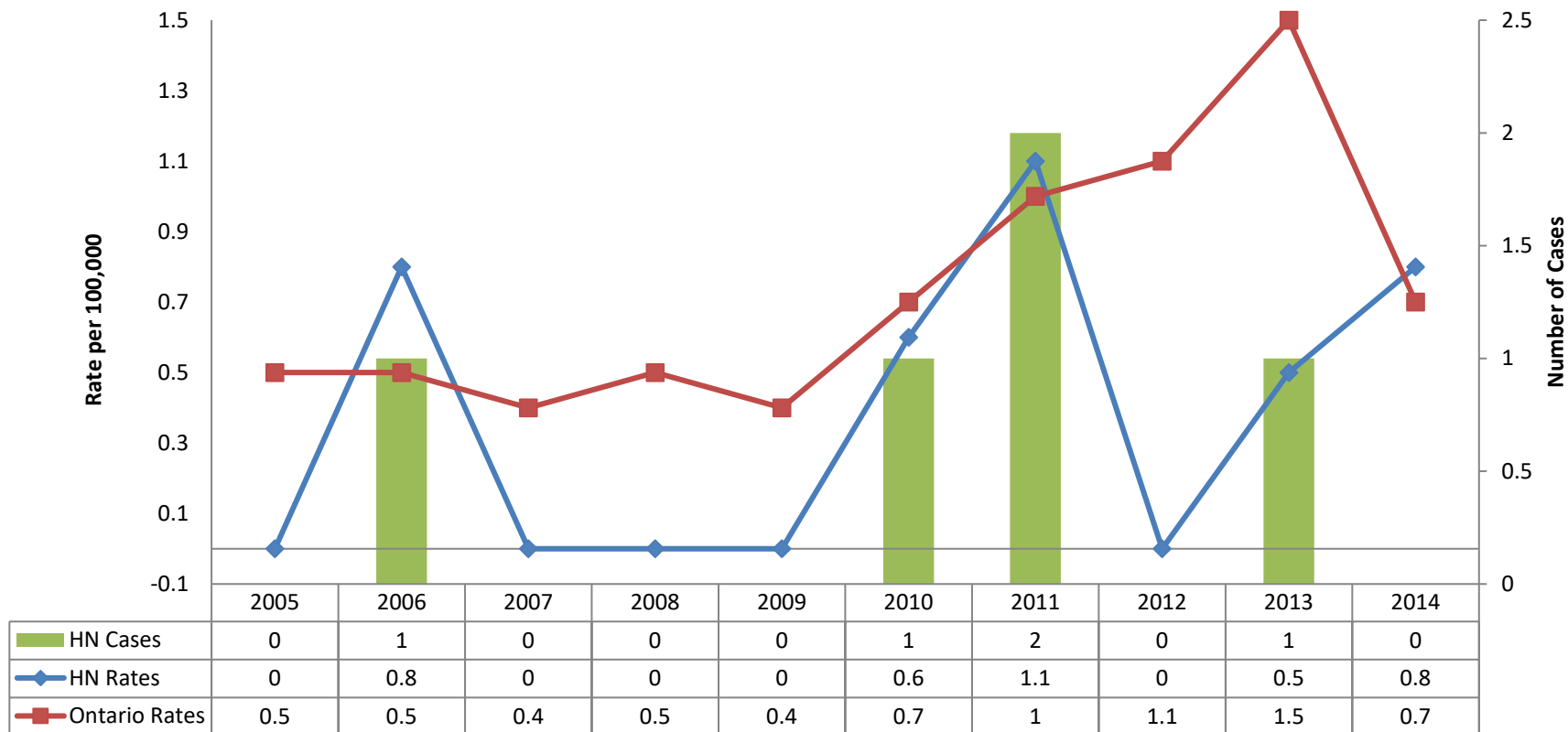
Incidence of HIV, Age Standardized Rate, Haldimand and Norfolk, 2005-2014

- ❖ Between 2005 and 2014, the average number of cases of Pertussis was 5. However, there were no Pertussis cases reported in 2010, in Haldimand and Norfolk.
- ❖ From 2005 to 2014 there were two peaks noted in 2011 (n=10) and 2013 (n=9)

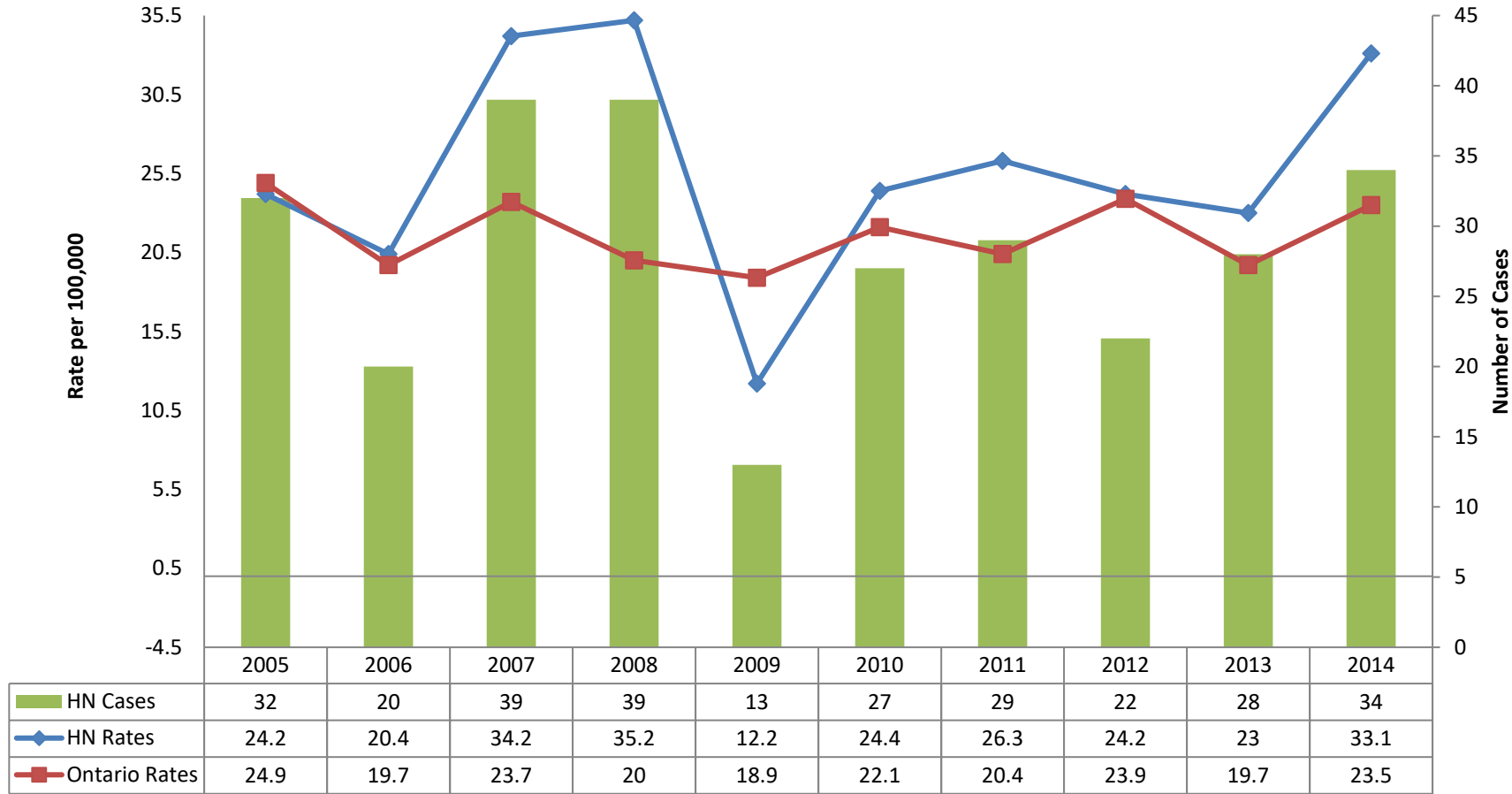
Incidence of Pertussis, Age Standardized Rate, Haldimand and Norfolk, 2005-2014

❖ Between 2005 and 2014, the average number of cases of Salmonellosis was 28, in Haldimand and Norfolk.

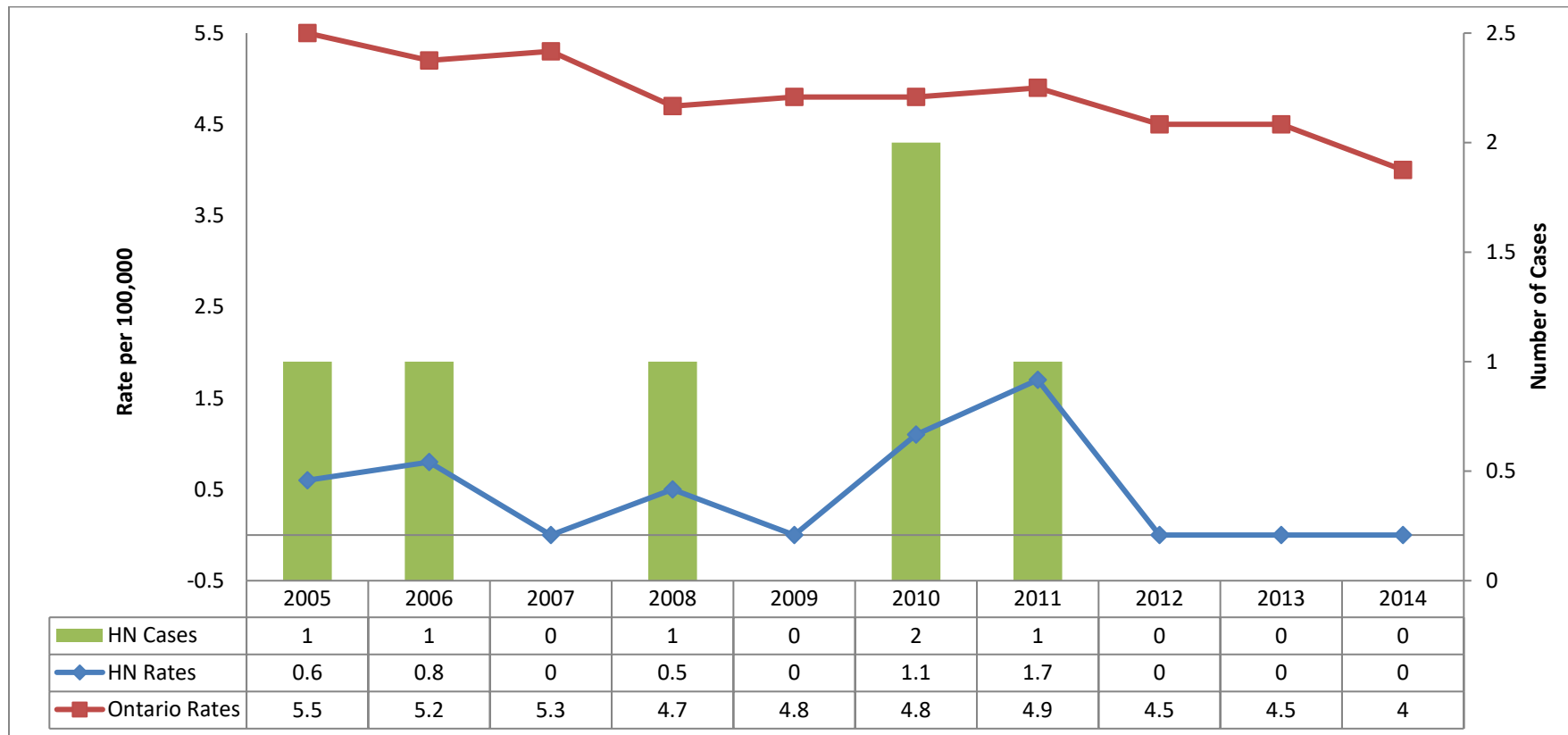
Incidence of Salmonellosis, Age Standardized Rate, Haldimand and Norfolk, 2005-2014

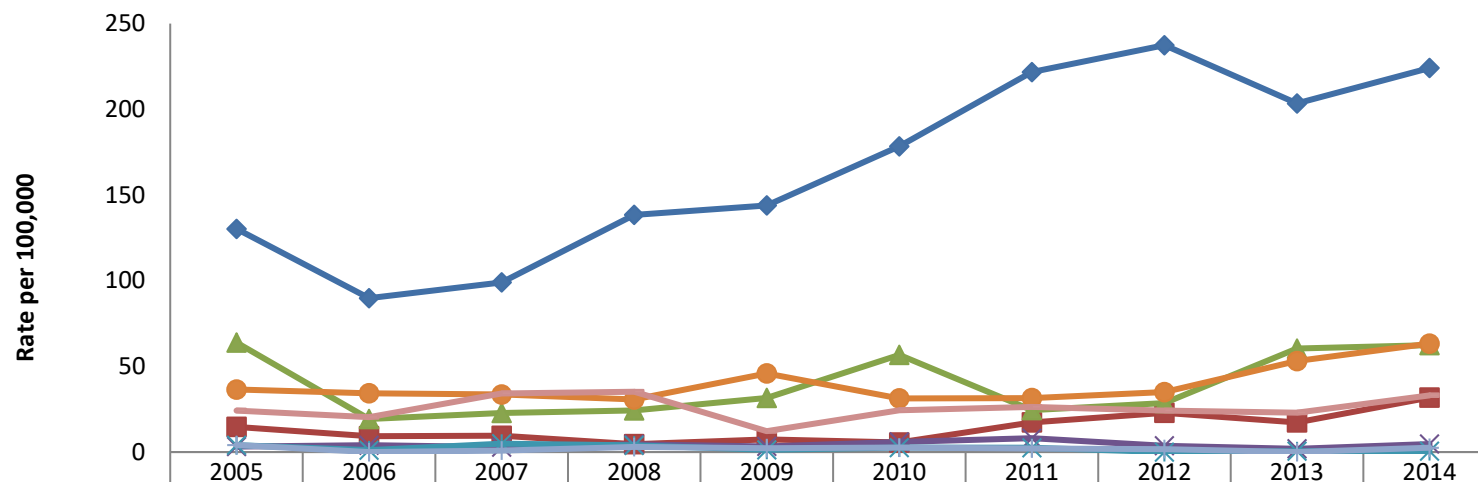
❖ Between 2005 and 2014, the average number of cases of Tuberculosis was 1, in Haldimand and Norfolk.
