

Labour Force – Statistics in Haldimand and Norfolk

- ❖ 61.9% of residents aged 15 years and over participate in the labour force in Haldimand and Norfolk compared to 64.7% in Ontario.
- ❖ 57.6% of the population are employed while 6.9% are unemployed in Haldimand and Norfolk.

Date Notes: 'Labour force': Refers to persons who, during the week of Sunday, May 1 to Saturday, May 7, 2016, were either employed or unemployed. '**Employment rate'**: The employment rate for a particular group (age, sex, marital status, geographic area, etc.) is the number of employed persons in that group, expressed as a percentage of the total population in that group. '**Unemployment rate'**: The unemployment rate for a particular group (age, sex, marital status, geographic area, etc.) is the unemployed in that group, expressed as a percentage of the labour force in that group. '**Participation rate'**: The participation rate for a particular group (age, sex, marital status, geographic area, etc.) is the total labour force in that group, expressed as a percentage of the total population in that group.
