TO: To All Residents and Visitors of Norfolk County and Haldimand County

RE: SECTION 22 ORDER – EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

I, as the Medical Officer of Health, am of the opinion, based on reasonable and probable grounds, that:

1. a communicable disease exists or may exist or there is an immediate risk of an outbreak of a communicable disease in the Health Unit served by me;
2. the communicable disease presents a risk to the health of persons in the health unit served by me; and
3. the requirements specified in this order are necessary in order to decrease or eliminate the risk to health presented by the communicable disease.

Therefore, I am issuing the following Section 22 Order, under the *Health Protection and Promotion Act* (Act), R.S.O. 1990, c.H.7:

1. My orders, dated March 22, 2020 and April 3, 2020, which are attached to this Order, are revoked.
2. Piers and beaches which are normally accessible to the public, whether privately or publicly owned, are closed to residents of and visitors to Norfolk County and Haldimand County.
3. Residents of and visitors to Norfolk County and Haldimand County must practice physical distancing of at least 2 m between themselves and others who are not within their household unit.
4. Private outdoor amenity equipment and space at residential properties may only be used by persons who reside at that residential property.

TAKE NOTICE THAT you have the right to a hearing before the Health Services Appeal and Review Board in accordance with Section 44 of the Health Protection and Promotion Act. You must mail or deliver a notice in writing requesting a hearing to the undersigned and to the Health Services Appeal and Review Board, 151 Bloor St. W., Toronto, Ontario M5S 2T5, within 15 days after this Order is served on you.

AND TAKE FURTHER NOTICE THAT although a hearing may be requested, this Order takes effect when it is served upon you.

FAILURE to comply with this Order is an offence for which an individual may be liable, on conviction, to a fine of not more than \$5,000 for every day or part of each day on which the offence occurs or continues.

You are hereby ordered to take the following actions:

1. Residents of Norfolk County and Haldimand County are not to congregate in groups larger than 10 in public spaces within the Health Unit, including playgrounds, parks, piers and beaches.
2. No person is to use playground equipment.

THE REASON(S) for this ORDER is that:

1. There is the potential for transmission of the COVID-19 virus among residents in Norfolk County and Haldimand County.

Therefore, based on the reason(s) noted above, I am of the opinion, on reasonable and probable grounds that:

1. a communicable disease exists or may exist or there is an immediate risk of an outbreak of a communicable disease in the health unit served by me;
2. the communicable disease presents a risk to the health of persons in the health unit served by me; and
3. the requirements specified in this order are necessary in order to decrease or eliminate the risk to health presented by the communicable disease.

A Section 22 Order, under the *Health Protection and Promotion Act (HPPA)*, R.S.O. 1990, c.H.7 has been issued by Dr. Shanker Nesathurai, Medical Officer of Health of the Haldimand Norfolk Health Unit to all residents of Norfolk County and Haldimand County.

You are hereby ordered to take the following actions. Residents of and visitors to Norfolk County and Haldimand County are not permitted to

1. Use or access any open space, including parks, trails, piers, beaches, community gardens, or other open spaces usually accessible to the public, whether publicly or privately owned;
2. Use or access of any outdoor recreational equipment normally accessible to the public, whether privately or publicly owned, including playground equipment, outdoor fitness equipment, and sports fields or sports amenities, such as tennis courts, BMX parks and skate parks;
3. Use private outdoor amenity spaces or equipment unless use is solely by persons who reside at the property;

THE REASON(S) for this ORDER is that:
