

## Population Size – Statistics in Haldimand and Norfolk

- ❖ The population of the Haldimand and Norfolk was 109,787.
- ❖ Between 2011 and 2016, the population of Haldimand and Norfolk increased by 0.6% while Ontario increased by 4.6%.
- ❖ Norfolk County has a larger population compared to Haldimand County (Haldimand County: 45,608; Norfolk County: 64,044).
- ❖ Haldimand and Norfolk has 48,249 private dwellings and the population density per square kilometer is 37.9.
- ❖ The population and geographic area is highest in Simcoe, compared to other urban areas.
- ❖ The population growth rate is highest in Hagersville, compared to other urban areas (2011 to 2016).
