

Smoking Status – Statistics in Haldimand and Norfolk

- ❖ 21.5% of Haldimand and Norfolk adults, age 20 years and older, smoked daily or occasionally compared to 18.9% of Ontario adults (2013-14).
- ❖ 82.9% of Haldimand and Norfolk youth, aged 12 to 18 years, completely abstained from smoking cigarettes in their lifetime (never smoked a whole cigarette in their lifetime) (2013-14).
