
Special Event Face Painter Requirements

Face painting is considered a personal service and Special Event Vendors are required to follow all requirements laid out in **GEPH's** Guidelines for Vendors Offering Personal Services Booklet.

Below is a checklist for the basic requirements of a face painting vendor:

- ✓ An adequate amount of single use disposable face sponges on site.
- Reusable paint brushes are to be cleaned in soapy water, then soaked in 70-90% isopropyl alcohol for 10 minutes after each client.
- Paint needed for each client is dispensed on a single-use item such as a paper plate; the plate is disposed of after each client.
- A temporary hand wash station with soap & paper towels in dispensers is required. Hands are to be washed when visibly soiled.

- ✓ Apply hand sanitizer or wash hands (if visibly soiled) between clients.
- Paint palettes are covered when not in use and are to be cleaned and disinfected, using a low-level disinfectant, at the end of the day. For low level disinfectants, please refer to page 104 of the Guide to Infection Prevention and Control in Personal Service Settings.
