**PHI Education to Operator:**

- ☐ Unpasteurized milk and/or milk products not sold or offered freely to the public
- ☐ Ungraded domestic hen eggs and/or egg products not sold or offered freely to the public
- ☐ Eggs from animals (other than domestic hens) must be free from cracks, clean and held at 4°Celsius (40° Fahrenheit) or lower.
- ☐ Animal vaccinations are up-to-date, signed by a licensed veterinarian and available on-site.
- ☐ Birthing areas should be restricted to the public.
- ☐ Animals that are too young to be vaccinated for rabies are not accessible to the public
- ☐ Process in place for animals who are ill or injured at the time of the event
- ☐ Process in place to report any animal bite to the Grand Erie Public Health
- ☐ Process in place for the cleaning of the animal enclosure
- ☐ Protective equipment (such as helmets) are available where required
- ☐ If dirtied, equipment should be washed and sanitized with a bleach solution.
- ☐ Operator provided or referred to the MOHLTC's *Recommendations to Prevent Disease and Injury Associated with Petting Zoos in Ontario* document.
