

Visible Minority – Statistics in Haldimand and Norfolk

- ❖ In Haldimand and Norfolk, 2.1% of the population identify as a visible minority.
- ❖ A higher percentage of persons who reported that they were non-Caucasian in race or non-white in colour, were Black (35.6%), followed by South Asian (14.7%), Chinese (10.7%) and Filipino (10.7%).
